Who: Richardson Sadeki (designer); Klai Juba Architects (architect)
When: March 2004
How big: 15,000 square feet, 9 treatment areas, 4 private tubs, 5 pools
Wow factor: Grotto-like bathing in a soothing labyrinth of Brazilian slate.

Who: SFA Design (designer); TSA of Nevada (architect)
When: July 2004
How big: 855,000 square feet, 1,100 rooms
Wow factor: Custom backlit onyx reception desks and an Italian-style garden.

Who: CCS Architecture (designer/architect)
When: January 2005
How big: 16,000 square feet; 450 seats
Wow factor: The second floor is contained by a mahogany and glass box that juts out into the hotel atrium.

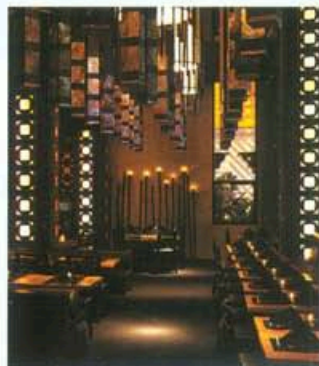

How big: 217 acres, 2,716 guest rooms, 18 restaurants, and Wynn's private art collection.
Wow factor: Yabu Pushelberg (La Flirt cosmetics store and Wynn & Company Jewelry); David Ling Architect (Outfit, Shoe-In, Gizmo, Wynn & Company Watches, all high-end boutiques); Robin Kramer (Mojitos Resort Wear clothing store); and ABA Avery Brooks & Associates (Pro Shop golf store and W.ink, a luxury writing instruments and eyewear boutique).
